Places are held until 9:30 a.m. then unclaimed ones will be available to others. The art club charges no commission and reserves the right to reject any work considered by the club board to be unacceptable. We will confirm your reservation and assign your space # according to date of receipt of application. No refunds or raindates.

A number will be assigned to you from the enclosed map. Please refer to the map for your location. Space sizes vary, however most will accommodate a 10x10 canopy. Auxiliary spaces A-G are 9x10 and a canopy CANNOT be used. Spaces 3-12 must back-up 1' over the curb and into the park space behind so your canopy must be adjustable. This is to create a 13' fire lane down Main Street as required by the Fire Dept. PLEASE CHECK MAP.

SET UP TIMES IN THE PLAYGROUND AREA ARE 7:30-9:30 A.M. TO ACCOMMODATE VISITORS IN NEARBY HOTEL. . . ALSO NO STAKES ARE TO BE USED ON ANY GRASSY AREAS.

All artists are welcome whose work is ORIGINAL. ALL WORK MUST BE HAND-CRAFTED AND DESIGNED BY THE EXHIBITOR. NO MASS PRODUCED WORK. Because of complaints by the retail community this rule will be strictly enforced. Please send photos of your space set-up and close-ups representing your work. All photos will be juried since the club aims to maintain the high quality of the show. Note: Due to the volume of requests, all jewelry applications will be held until April 1 when they will be juried together. A limited number will be selected.

Make a \$90.00 check or money order payable to the Saugatuck Douglas Art Club for the booth fee. Enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope along with your application and photographs. Apply early for best spaces. See you in July.
